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Long-term investing in financial markets is one of the most effective ways to build wealth over time, but the tools to understand how to make informed investing decisions are often difficult to access for many young people. The *JA Take Stock in Your Future* program introduces high school students to investing concepts and the stock market through an engaging classroom curriculum. Students then participate in a classroom or school-based JA Stock Market competition, with top teams advancing to JA New York's JA Stock Market Challenge® Final Competition.

The JA Stock Market Challenge is an exciting, hands-on event that immerses students in the experience of trading and investing through a dynamic, simulated stock market. Teams research and invest their portfolio from a pool of fictional stocks modeled after real-life companies. Each simulated trading day features news from the financial markets, requiring students to analyze the information and make investment decisions as they reevaluate their portfolios.

> Demystifying the stock market for a new generation, encouraging them to become informed, responsible, and successful investors.



2024 Impact



In spring 2024, JA New York and Amazon hosted the inaugural JA Stock Market Challenge with additional support from Barclays. This capstone event experience leveraged what students learned as part of JA Take Stock in Your Future and brought together over 70 high school students from five schools across the Greater New York region to test their investing skills and compete to maximize their portfolios' value.

Over the course of 60 simulated "days," students honed their skills in negotiation, clear communication, and resource management, interacting with volunteers from Amazon and Barclays as they directed their own trades. A total of 22 teams collaborated with volunteer "floor traders" to analyze news and make strategic trades throughout the competition.

Through JA Take Stock in Your Future, students discover the benefits and challenges of investing in the stock market as part of a broader, long-term investment strategy and the risks and rewards of trading.

After completing the classroom curriculum, students and teachers are invited to compete in the JA Stock Market Challenge, where high school students compete by investing and trading fake funds in the real market creating draft portfolios as teams, and finalizing their stock selections.
