JA in a Day events bring our network of corporate and community volunteers into classrooms to teach students essential financial literacy, entrepreneurship, and work-readiness skills using JA's proprietary classroom-based curriculum. The JA Stock Market Challenge is an exciting, hands-on event that immerses students in the experience of trading and investing through a dynamic, simulated stock market. Teams research and invest their portfolio from a pool of fictional stocks modeled after real-life companies. Each simulated trading day features news from the financial markets, requiring students to analyze the information and make investment decisions as they reevaluate their portfolios.




