JA Finance Park® is an innovative learning experience designed to equip young people with the knowledge and skills they need to understand and manage their personal finances. The program blends classroom instruction with an immersive on-site simulation which helps students build a foundation on which they can make intelligent financial decisions that last a lifetime.

PROGRAM THEMES

- Identify personal interests, skills, work preferences, and values.
- Evaluate the risks and benefits of saving and investing.
- Understand risk and recognize insurance as a way to mitigate it.
- Define taxes, explain their purpose, and understand their impact on everyone.
- Explain the importance and use of budgets.
- Create a successful budget based on hypothetical life scenarios.



JA Finance Park Content Areas



Employment and Education

Participants explore the value of postsecondary education, focusing on the costs, benefits, and career impacts of their choices. They also learn essential financial skills, including how to pay for education, complete the FAFSA, and interpret financial aid award letters.



Financial Responsibility and Decision Making

Students learn to make informed financial decisions and understand the responsibilities that come with them, developing their skills in financial goal planning, smart consumer practices, and responsible credit use. They also learn about the impact of taxes, the benefits of charitable giving, and the importance of understanding the cost of living in different regions.



Planning and Money Management

Participants learn the essentials of budgeting by distinguishing between needs and wants, and apply these skills to budgeting for extracurricular activities and managing cashless spending. They also learn about the importance of preparing for unexpected expenses and the role of an emergency fund in maintaining financial stability.



Risk Management and Insurance

Participants learn the importance of life, health, and disability insurance for young adults. They explore the various types of auto insurance, understanding costs, coverage, and strategies to manage premiums. The program also covers the fundamentals of mortgages, including payment structures and comparing different types of mortgage options.

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Investing

Students explore various investment types and work together to create a diversified portfolio. They learn the basics of stock market investing, evaluate market factors, and are introduced to key investing strategies. The program also emphasizes the importance of early and consistent retirement savings, highlighting the consequences of inadequate retirement funding.




